



## The 2014 Loudoun Laurels Stewardship Trust Scholarship Application

### Overview

Loudoun Laurels Stewardship Trust Scholarships will be presented in 2015 to three (3) Loudoun County High School seniors thanks to generous gifts to the Loudoun Laurels Foundation.

Each scholarship is a onetime, academic scholarship in the amount of \$10,000.00, and is to be used solely for college/university tuition and fees, or for community college tuition and fees if the recipient is part of a program guaranteeing transfer to a four-year institution

Scholarships may be renewed on the basis of good performance for each of the four years required to earn an undergraduate degree,.

### Requirements

- ✓ Students must reside within Loudoun County
- ✓ Students must attend a Loudoun County High School
- ✓ Students must be seniors
- ✓ Students must be enrolling in a 4-year undergraduate program for the upcoming Fall semester OR in a community college program that guarantees admission to a four-year institution upon successful completion of the community college degree.
- ✓ Students must be enrolling in a Virginia institution (public or private)
- ✓ In 2015 TWO scholarships will be awarded to students planning to pursue a degree in a STEM- (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) focused program.
- ✓ In 2015 ONE scholarship, the Middleburg Bank Joseph L. Boling Scholarship, will be awarded to a students planning to pursue a degree in a program focused on the liberal arts.
